Project Introduction

Funded by the NSW Department of Education, Arthur Phillip High School is the first public high-rise high school to be built in NSW. Each year group of 330 students has been provided with their own atrium & mezzanine level complete with gym & playground, offering full access to terraces incorporating meshed outdoor areas for social interactions. The school's specialty rooms, such as the science laboratories, are located on the upper levels of the new building. The school incorporates state-of-the-art, technology-rich & flexible learning spaces with adaptable / moveable furniture & room configurations, promoting innovative & collaborative learning. The existing school buildings built in the 1960s were demolished to create more green space on the site.
