The Cessnock Correctional Centre was expanded as part of the NSW Government's \$3.8 billion investment to increase prison capacity across the state. The project comprises accommodation blocks for a new 330-bed maximum-security wing, Gate House, Reception, Visiting Area, Programs Building & Health Facility to support the expanded centre.
