The Repatriation General Hospital, South Australia, was built by the Commonwealth Government to care for servicemen returning from World War II. After years of service to the community & a reorganisation of service provisions, under the SA Transforming Health program, the State Government redeveloped the hospital to provide additional facilities to the community:

- Ward 5-8: COVID-19 Facilities
- Ward 18: Neurobehavioural Unit
- Ward 20: Specialist Adv. Dementia Unit (SADU)
