Project Introduction

The Satellite Hospital Program (SHP) comprised seven new facilities to support public healthcare delivery in southeast Queensland; Tugun, Kallangur, Eight Mile Plains, Bribie Island, Ripley, Caboolture & Redland Bay.

The satellite hospitals have been built in major growth areas to allow people to access healthcare services in a purpose-built community setting, closer to home, without having to travel to a major hospital's emergency department.

- **pre-start meetings** with each project team to ensure the requirements were clear;

- **Engineering support** & advice where there were discrepancies between the drawings & technical data provided;
- **Architectural Training Manuals** based on the documentation collated for presentation to the hospital by Hutchison Builders
