Project Introduction

The Law Courts building is part of the landmark Robson Square complex in downtown Vancouver. The Law Courts building occupies the southern block of the complex, provincial government offices the middle block, & the Vancouver Art Gallery (previous post) the northern block. The building is used exclusively by the two higher courts of the Province of British Columbia: the Supreme Court & the Court of Appeal. The air conditioning & ventilation systems were upgraded in Blocks 51, 61, & 71.
