Project Introduction

Oakridge Centre opened in 1959, was one of Vancouver's first major shopping malls, featuring a mix of retail stores, restaurants, & community spaces. However, by the 2000s, the mall faced challenges common to aging retail spaces, prompting discussions about its future. In 2015, the City of Vancouver approved a redevelopment plan to revitalize the area while preserving its community spirit. Spanning 28 acres, the project includes residential buildings, shops, parks, & community amenities such as green areas to encourage outdoor activities & social interaction.
